Cap Classique

Pierre Jourdan Belle Rose(Franschhoek)

R105/420

Created in the traditional French method of bottle fermentation known as Cap Classique in South Africa. Enjoy a full nose of strawberries and cream, followed by fresh acidity and red fruit on the palate.

Simonsig Kaapse Vonkel Brut 2020 (Stellenbosch)

R110/450

On the nose, crisp green apples supported by subtle aromas of pear and shortbread biscuits. Refreshing fruit driven flavours followed by a delicate mineral finish on the palate.

Mukanya Brut Rose (Cape Winelands)

R115/530

60% Pinot Noir/40% Chardonnay. This is a delicate expression of citrus notes and hints of red berries. On palate elegant freshness combines seamlessly with classic richness and finishes with finesse.

Noble Hill Blanc De Blanc 2020 (Paarl)

R125/540

Fruit notes include melon, pineapple, and hibiscus flower. Mineral notes elicit flint stone covered in moss. The structure of the wine is linear with racy acidity balanced by rich fruit

Colmant Brut (Franschhoek)

R645

Colmant Brut Reserve displays the house style, offering sophisticated freshness and elegance while revealing precision in acidity and the balance of flavours. 50% Chardonnay and 50% pinot noir.

Le Lude Brut (Franschhoek)

R180/795

Delightful, pale lemon/straw colour. Chardonnay-dominant, light, blossom with lemon and pear. The palate also shows that little biscuity, creamy richness, such sweet and ripe fruit, and lemon.

Pieter Ferreira Blanc de Blanc 2017(Cape Wineland)

R1250

On the eye it shows an enchanting luminous straw colour. The bubbles are persistent and extremely fine in the glass. The experience on the palate is a display of classic yeasty tones that have layers of flavours expressing lime pith, citrus peel and green almond, the wine finishing on a comforting brioche note.

L'ormarins Private Cuvee 2015 (Franschhoek)

R1500

Pale lemon colour, bright and clear, with a hypnotic steady stream of vigorous, fine bubbles. The nose offers up subtle orange blossom



White Blends

Haute Cabriere Chardonnay Pinot Noir 2023 (Franschhoek) R75/320

Enjoy fresh citrus flavours underpinned by white peach and red fruit, with balanced acidity. The blend is 60% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir

Oldenburg <CL white blend 2022 (Stellenbosch) R110/440

A divine citrus character persists on the nose, revealing an exquisite array of fragrances including invigorating. lemon zest, delicate elderflowers. . It has a blend of 78% Chardonnay and 22% Chenin Blanc

Mullineux Old Vines White 2022 (Swartland) R980

The nose is reminiscent of creamy butterscotch, hazelnuts, and biscuit. Semillon gives a wonderful creaminess. and texture, Delicate wooding makes it an excellent food wine and it pairs beautifully with rich seafood. 74% Chenin Blanc, 8% Clairette Blanche, 6% Grenache Blanc, 7% Viognier and 5% Semillon.

Tokara Director's Reserve 2021 (Stellenbosch) R1000

The nose is complex, exhibiting attractive aromas of passionfruit and pink grapefruit with hints of cassis and freshly. toasted brioche. On the palate the wine enters full and rich, reminiscent of the aromas on the nose. It has amazing. clarity and depth with a zesty persistence. Sauvignon Blanc 72% Sauvignon Blanc, 28% Semillon

Chenin Blanc

Kloof Street Chenin Blanc 2022 (Franschhoek) R75/290

This wine has a nose of sun ripened pears and wet granite. The palate has a vibrant acidity balanced by a soft, round texture and some pithy character. The wine has a fresh, mineral finish.

Rainbow's End Chenin 2022 (Stellenbosch) R80/320

Delicate floral and tropical aromas on the nose with a touch pineapple and litchi The wine shows a fresh fruit driven palate with ripe yellow peaches. Good acidity is balanced with a fruity finish.

Leopards Leap Culnaria Chenin Blanc 2022 (Franschhoek) R420

A well-defined ripe fruit character with aromas of tropical fruit and yellow peach are balanced with refreshing. white fruit such as pear. A hint of sweet spice charms the nose while a vibrant acidity.

Oldenburg Chenin Blanc 2022 (Stellenbosch) R740

This vintage of Chenin Blanc displays a stunning array of aromas and flavours! The nose showcases a gentle. citrus pith, with hints of beeswax and honey. Burnt orange peel and vibrant notes of nartjie and ginger add to floral hues of jasmine and chamomile.

Stone Trail Single Vineyard Chenin Blanc 2019 (Franschhoek) R880

Concentrated yet fresh, with mouth-filling white pear, quince, and gooseberry, followed by aromatic almond. blossom and a balanced lingering finish, along with a bright, focused acidity and earthy minerality which should see it age well.



Sauvignon Blanc

Stony Brook Sauvignon Blanc 2022 (Franschhoek)

R80/320

The extended lees-ageing on this wine allows for a restrained fruit profile of passion fruit and pear on the nose. While bright and fresh, the palate is remarkably full, with intense concentration, zest, and richness in the finish.

Ken Forrester Sauvignon Blanc 2023(Stellenbosch)

R90/370

Lovely complexity with mix of tropical fruit, tangy grassy notes, fig leaves & nectarine nuances with crisp dry finish. Duplex soils, fine sandy loam on a clay base

Springfield Life From Stone Sauvignon Blanc 2023 (Robertson)

R420

Stones have no flavour that they impart on wine - they simply make the soil less. If there is less soil the vine produces more concentrated fruit, the same happens with old vines, also when vines are planted in high

La Motte Pierneef Sauvignon Blanc 2022 (Franschhoek)

R450

Pale straw colour, on the nose tropical fruit and lemon grass, Dry on the palate, offering aromas of gooseberries and lingering fresh finish

Bamboes Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2022 (Bamboes Bay)

R860

A vibrant mix of clean herbaceous and tangy passion fruit aromas, with wisps of intense fresh seaweed and gravelly crunch in the background. The palate shows a full lingering powerful combination of ripe Citrus, Stone fruit and Lemon Grass. The elegance it shows is backed by a succulent acid framework and subtle minerality.

Semillon

Haut Espoir Sémillon 2018 (Franschhoek)

R500

Typical of Franschhoek Semillon, the nose is floral with hints of lime and citrus. The overall creamy mouthfeel due to the time on gross lees and barrel ageing is balanced with chalky minerality. The finish is complex with lingering, nutty aromas After racking off gross lees, the wine matured a further 11 months in barrel before bottling.

Wade Bales Franschhoek Sémillon 2021 (Franschhoek)

R100/560

A Subtle nose of restrained lemon zest and lemon leaf, with a touch of dust and nettle That lemon zip and vivacity is immediately apparent in the mouth. Succulent and fresh. The brightness balanced by a rich palate weight and texture indicative of time spend in the oak

Boekenhoutskloof Semillon 2020 (Franschhoek)

R800

Aromas of mandarin orange, tangerine peel, pineapple and fragrant blossoms and gentle whiffs of angelica, lemon verbena, nettles and spicy oak nuances all adding intensity to the citrus character. Layers of vibrant. The pure flavours of kumquat, grenadilla, yellow apple and preserved lemon dominant.

The Dark Side Of The Vine Semillon 2020 (Franschhoek)

R1100

The wine displays a wonderfully intense aromatic nose with sensational lemon and lime zest and perfume. It unfurls wave upon wave of lemon confit, fresh peach juice, dried herbs, crushed walnut, nutmeg, tangerine peel, wet stones and dry thatch nuances



Chardonnay

Haute Cabriere Unwooded Chardonnay 2023 (Franschhoek) R80/340

A blend of Chardonnay vineyards coming together and expressing lychee and citrus on the nose with lime and Pear On the palate. Well balanced acidity adds freshness and complexity.

La Bri Chardonnay 2022 (Franschhoek) R110/450

Clean and precise, this wine embraces the joy of quince and creamy lime with a hint of freshly baked. biscuits all offset against a backdrop of the minerality of sun-baked slate in the first summer rain.

Stony Brook Ghost Gum 2021 (Franschhoek) R500

This fragrant white wine has the characteristic floral nose with notes of orange blossom, apricots, it, mandarins and cardamom. The richly textured palate is balanced by fresh and vibrant flavours. reminiscent of peach, grapefruit, and hints of spice. The nose is reminiscent of creamy butterscotch, hazelnuts, and biscuit

Warwick The White Lady Chardonnay 2021 (Stellenbosch) R1200

The White Lady has established herself as a dominant force in South African Chardonnay. This richly textured wooded white has twice been named Platter White Wine of the year and has garnered 5-star ratings over the past six consecutive vintages

Capensis Chardonnay 2019 (Stellenbosch) R1700

Capensis Western Cape Chardonnay is a culmination of five remarkable vineyards. a balanced, layered, and complex expression of the region. Crafted to age. gracefully and gain complexity over time, pure citrus and rich minerality drive a focused, world-class Chardonnay.

Rosé Styled And Blanc De Noir

Lynx Blanc De Noir 2023 (Franschhoek) R70/280

Named after the abundance of beautiful wildflowers that appear every spring on the Fable Mountain, this provençe style rosé is made from carefully selected parcels of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Bone dries with a low alcohol of only 12%. Beautifully layered aromatics of wild berries and roses which are supported by a powerful yet precise. Palette

Simonsig Needless To Say Rose 2023 (Stellenbosch) R70/280

This rose showcases a colour of cotton candy sunset radiating from the glass, its aromatic profile has wonderful. aromas of strawberry sherbet, passion fruit and ripe pineapple with subtle notes of white blossoms. On the palate a zesty tingle of acidity carries the fruit with a light creamy texture.

Rainbow's End Cab Franc Blanc de Noir 2023 (Stellenbosch) R80/340

The nose is vibrant with aromas of white flowers and freshly sliced apples. The flavours are. bright and linger with fresh fruit and hints of ruby grapefruit. The wine is well balanced, dry with a refreshing yet subtle acidity and a hint of minerality.

Holden Manz Hiro Rose 2023 (Franschhoek) R580

The wine is made in true Provençal style. Dry and fruit-driven, the wine is made from 90% Grenache and 10% Cinsault. Grapes are hand-harvested early morning at around 23 balling. The wine is matured on fine lees for additional 9 months with a regular battónage before the final blending.



La Motte Millenium 2021 (Franschhoek)**R85/340**

It is a blend of Merlot 51%, Cabernet Franc 35%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10%, and Petit Verdot 4%. A dusty, earthy nose with raspberry and mulberry fruit, cinnamon spice, and a hint of mint, promising a complex wine

Stony Brook The Max 2019 (Franschhoek)**R500**

This vintage integrated tannins and a bright, elegant finish and just a hint of oak is a Cape Bordeaux-style blend, made up of 44% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, 13% Cabernet Franc and 10% Petit Verdot. The nose offers dark chocolate, ripe cherry, cigar box and caramelised

Anthonij Rupert Optima 2020 (Franschhoek)**R600**

37% Merlot, 35% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Cabernet Franc] Violet, blackberry, cherry, cocoa, spice, and fruit-cake scents instantly seduce. In a single whiff, classic Black Forest gateau. The mouth is soft, rounded, velvety

Kanonkop Paul Sauer 2020 (Stellenbosch)**R2300**

A Bordeaux-style blend of Cabernet Sauvignon 69%, Merlot 19 %, and Cabernet Franc 12 %. till youthful, it has Subtle reduction, well-integrated new French oak, chocolate, cassis, blueberry and bramble flavours and sinewy, age-worthy tannins

Leeu Passant 2020 (Franschhoek)**R4200**

45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cinsault A fine wine, inspired by the great Cinsault-Cab-blends of the previous century, The Leeu Passant is something very special and well worth spending ample time with to enjoy the unique reflection of each portion of the blend

Cinsault

Waterkloof Cinsault 2022 (False Bay)**R80/320**

The old bush vines gave rise to a soft, vibrant, and yet structured wine. It is playful in its aromas with loads of light red berries, pronounced florals and slight earthy notes. In the mouth, the prominent fruit aromatics are complemented by soft tannins with great length.

Sanniesrust Cinsaut 2022 (Stellenbosch)**R350**

It is made from the Cinsault cultivar and has notes of raspberry, pomegranate, and cherries. It spent a few months on the lees after being bottled unoaked

Fryers Crove Grenache Cinsault 2023 (Cape West Coast)**R450**

This medium-bodied wine is bright and exuberant in colour with light violet hues. It is packed with aromas of wild. raspberry and a hint of clove spice. It boasts smooth tannins with a balanced acidity, giving it a seductive round. finish. It is a blend of 50% Cinsault and 50% Grenache noir

Rickety Bridge Paulina Reserve Old Vine Cinsault 2021 (Franschhoek) R1200

It's an ethereal and enchanting rendition of the variety. The nose shows subtle notes of cherry, red currant, rose and fynbos while the palate has lovely fruit integrity and flavour intensity without being weighty . It's a wonderfully balanced wine with bright acidity and fine, powdery tannins, the finish nicely dry -



Pinot noir

Iona Mr P Knows Pinot Noir 2023 (Elgin)

R105/430

Elegant, fresh cherry and red berry nose, with undergrowth melange. The palate is pure with lovely texture and sweet cherry fruit dominates with spicy undertones. The wine is fresh and intense with real vibrancy.

Chamonix Feldspar Pinot Noir 2020 (Franschhoek)

R520

The bouquet is complex with scents recalling wild berries, spice, sour cherries, and violets. On the palate the wine shows a medium body with fruit flavours and elegant tannins, leading to a long finish

Haute Cabriere Reserve 2020 (Franschhoek)

R640

This wine is aged for 11 months in specially selected French oak barrels to showcase the vintage characteristics of red berries, forest floor and cigar box, which are supported by well-rounded tannins.

Driehoek Cederburg Pinot Noir 2020 (Cederburg)

R780

A Pinot Noir showing an abundance of red fruit, cherries and raspberries with an earthy undertone and a hint of oak. A lingering taste of fruit with a smooth silky finish on the palate

Hamilton Russell Pinot Noir 2022 (Hermanus)

R1800

Our low-vigour, stony, clay-rich soil, cool maritime mesoclimate, naturally tiny yields of well under 35 hl/ha and Our philosophy of expressing our terroir in our wines - give rise to a certain tightness, tannin line and elevated length to balance the richness and generosity of our Pinot noir. Our Pinot noir is not overtly fruity, soft and "sweet" and it generally shows hints of that alluring savoury "primal" character along with a dark, spicy, complex primary fruit

Pinotage

Warwick The First Lady Pinotage 2022 (Stellenbosch)

R85/380

The First Lady Pinotage is a light and lively number that isn't shy of a bit of spice. In that sense, it's not unlike our legendary First Lady, Normal Ratcliffe, who became the first woman to serve as Chairperson for the prestigious Cape Winemakers' Guild. Her legend lives on in this range.

Groot Phesantekraal Pinotage 2021 (Durbanville)

R90/400

Vibrant red-purple hue in the glass with aromas of nutmeg, star anise cinnamon and subtle smoky undertones. On the palate a burst of mulberry and sour cherry which interlaces beautifully with the sweet spice. Subtle smokiness and balanced acidity linger on the finish

Chamonix Greywacke Pinotage 2020 (Franschhoek)

R500

The Greywacke Pinotage has a deep garnet red colour with tinges of dark violet when young. The bouquet is complex with scents recalling wild berries, spice and cherries. On the palate the wine shows full body and rich dark chocolate with fruit flavours, balanced elegantly by tannins, with a long and lingering finish that reveals a sweetness reminiscent of liquorice

Kanonkop Pinotage 2021 (Stellenbosch)

R1300

One of the world's finest examples of Pinotage, a variety first planted on Kanonkop in 1941. Deep garnet with a purple hue, this wine offers plush plum and cherry flavours with an evocative hint of spice. As the wine ages in the bottle, it gains an earthy, forest-floor character and a delectable cassis-like, sweet-fruited core.



Franschhoek Cellar Merlot 2022 (Franschhoek)**R70/280**

Merlot [87% Merlot, 8% Malbec, 5% Shiraz Bright ruby red with attractive plum and black cherry aromas tinged with herbal tea, liquorice and gentle oakspice. Soft and juicy with mouth-filling summer berry flavours

Boschendal 1685 Merlot 2020 (Franschhoek)**R420**

Rich red cherry and plum notes. Elegant cool climate style, good fruit intensity and length. Rich red cherry plum and pronounced ripe mulberry flavours. An elegant cool-climate style of wine with intensity of fruit and length. Good natural balance between primary fruit aromas,

Thelema Merlot 2020 (Stellenbosch)**R530**

The wine shows bright, red fruit and hints of spice on the nose, with concentrated flavours on the Palate and soft, polished tannins. Hints of dark chocolate complete this wonderfully balanced wine.

Shannon Mount Bullet Merlot 2020 (Elgin)**R1600**

The wine has a fragrance of ripe red fruits such as plums and dark cherries, with earthy complexity and yet still expressing minerality. Maintaining a good acidity lends to outstanding freshness with a well integrate ripe and seductive tannin structure. Incorporating a minimal winemaking intervention approach

Shiraz/Syrah**Little Eagle Shiraz 2017 (Constantia)****R80/420**

Perfume and floral aromas combine harmoniously with red cherry and spice on the nose. These flavours gracefully carry through to a savoury, spicy pallet, with aromas of star anees and cloves. These flavours are complimented by pure, clean red fruit flavours. Soft, well integrated tannins coat the pallet, leading to a distinct fresh finish.

La Motte Syrah 2018 (Franschhoek)**R525**

The full-bodied character of this red wine harmonises perfectly with rich, flavourful dishes, grilled foods including grilled vegetables), game dishes (particularly those incorporating stewed fruit and sweet aromatic spice. components, peppercorn-crusteds steaks and barbecued meat in a sticky, sweet sauce. The red wine's abundant fruit also latches onto the sweetness in jellies, chutneys and berry sauces

Mullineux Syrah 2020 (Swartland)**R750**

This Swartland Syrah has a classic perfume of wild-growing white Watsonia Lilies, fresh mulberries and black olive The structured palate follows through with intricate layers of kumquats, dark plums, sour cherry and star. anise and finishes with powerful and velvety tannins

Old Road 12 Mile Syrah 2021 (Franschhoek)**R800**

It is spicy and rich with textured layers and ripe, but fresh berry fruit. On the nose, there is inviting blackcurrant with aromatic notes of white pepper and coriander. On the palate soft, velvety tannins combine with lingering mulberry fruit and great structure for a memorable taste encounter.

Waterford Kevin Arnold Shiraz 2019 (Stellenbosch)**R900**

The wine shows aromatics of delicate violets, dark plum fruits and licorice notes which has layered subtle notes of earthiness and leather spice, brought in by the Mourvedre component. The palate follows the aromatics of the nose with similar violet and earthy spice notes. The wine shows generosity for a vintage which is known for more elegant and finely textured wines. The tannins presented are soft and granular with a fruit-forward finish due to the use of strictly older barrels for ageing



Cabernet Sauvignon

Topiary Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 (Franschhoek)

R90/380

Seductive nose of blackcurrant, sweet cherry and tobacco. Dominant red fruit palate with cedar and fine polished tannins. Fermentation takes place in open stainless-steel tanks and wild yeasts are used.

Holden Manz Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 (Franschhoek)

R645

An intense nose filled with a strong line of cassis and a whiff of cloves. Lesser notes of blackberry and pencil shaving. Refined dense palate with a complex array of fruits. The middle palate is full and shows width with complexity and depth leading to a long, full finish. Fine tannins combine tension and well balanced acidity

Rainbow's End Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 (Stellenbosch)

R700

The wine offers aromas of ripe plums and blue berries with nuances of fynbos and a touch of dark chocolate. The pallet offers bold ripe dark fruit with a slight herbaceous finish and lingering fine powdery tannins.

Anthonij Rupert Cabernet Sauvignon 2018 (Franschhoek)

R1550

Understated aromas of dark fruitcake, cherry blossom and subtle violet perfume with just a hint of cocoa powder. Impressive cohesion of nose and palate with those same fruitcake, cherry and violet notes being found in the mouth. Bright, lively and juicy but wonderfully dry and structured with impressive refinement. There's a good frame of oak around the fruit adding grip and length. Everything is balanced by fresh acidity, making for a rewarding, rounded mouthful. A long and generous wine.

Dessert Wine

Boschendal Vin D'Or Noble Late Harvest (Franschhoek)

R120

The forces of the vine and nature must come together in just the right way to create the purity that has earned this wine the moniker of 'liquid gold'. Vin D'Or - a naturally sweet blend that requires a touch of fate to sip a cherished opportunity - a captured moment of providence

Rickety Bridge The Gateway Straw Wine (Franschhoek)

R120

100% Colombar. Notes of apricots, honey suckle and straw. The sweetness is balanced out with a racy acidity.

Simonsig Gewurztraminer 2024 (Stellenbosch)

R85/360

A promising bright golden colour, with expressive notes of rose petals and juicy stone fruit on the nose. This Jamala Gewürztraminer leaves a creaminess and sweetness on the mid-palate with surprising notes of orange peel and a hint

of litchi. A bouquet of flavours and a subtle sweet finish make this wine a perfect companion to spicy dishes.

Lynx Viognier 2022 (Franschhoek)

R85/370

The Lynx Viognier is creamy and well-balanced with tropical fruit flavours and floral notes. This Viognier pairs well With spicy Asian cuisine. rich and luscious, filled with ripe pineapple, pear blossom, citrus and cinnamon spicing. The mouthfeel is full with a lengthy finish.

Chanteclair Malbec 2021 (Franschhoek)

R90/380

Malbec which was fermented in small open top fermenters and matured for 18 months in a selection of first and Second fill French oak barrels. Dark black fruit with a rich texture, combined with subtle firm tannins, make this Malbec ready to enjoy today or cellar for further complexity.

Nitida Riesling 2023 (Durbanville)

R95/450

Soft, delicate aromas of honeycomb, candied grapefruit, and citrus zest cascade over your palate like a waterfall. Scents of naartjie, dried apricot, and muscats create a vibrant and flavourful mix. A light sprinkling of aromatic Cardamom gently lingers

Rainbows End Cabernet Franc 2021 (Stellenbosch)

100% Cabernet Franc, Intense dark purple colour. Oak perfume with blackberry and hazel nut on the nose. Broad smooth tannins. Intense rich fruit and juicy palate.

Naude Grenache 2019 (Swartland)

Boekenhoutskloof Syrah 2008 (Franschhoek)

The nose is forthcoming and concentrated, with intense aromas of plums, violets and a sleek spiciness. The midpalate is pure, peppery and vibrant, with black and red fruits in abundance, showing flavours of blueberries, dark liquorice, anise and earthiness. The wine is full-bodied and very complex, with plush tannins.

Rust En Vrede- Red Blend 2007 (Stellenbosch)

R6000

Blend of 61% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Shiraz, 9% Merlot Colour - Deep crimson Red. Aroma - Savoury oak aromas combined with mocha coffee and pencil shavings. Hints of dark fruit, plum and cassis also come to the fore. Palate - This wine shows great structure and balance.
